Dear Parent/Carer

TRANSITION DAY INFORMATION

I am writing to confirm the dates and arrangements for your child's transition days. Schools, working in partnership across Buckinghamshire, have agreed that these days can, and should, take place. Schools will use a shared risk assessment regarding continued safety measures in the light of the on-going situation with Covid-19.

The transition days are on **Tuesday 6th and Wednesday 7th July** and will start at 9.00am and finish at 2.30pm. Information relating to safe procedures for dropping and collecting the children will be communicated to you nearer the time. All children should arrive wearing their primary school uniform and bring with them their writing equipment and a packed lunch. **We use a payment card system for payment in our restaurant, so there is no opportunity for students to purchase food on these two days.**

The students will meet other members of their form group, and their form tutor if at all possible. In line with the Buckinghamshire risk assessment, students' interactions will be with their form group only. The students will experience lessons taught by different subject specialist teachers and hopefully be involved in familiarization activities around the school site, dependent upon any Covid-19 restrictions in place at the time.

You will be able to book reserved appointment slots for uniform over the summer. The attached **flyer** provides **important branch appointment dates** and further detail on how these appointments will work in store. If you set up an account with Stevensons, you will then receive a notification when appointments go live which will be on a first-come, first-serve basis.
