

## Year 13 Parent/Carer Consultation Evening on Thursday 23<sup>rd</sup> February

Appointments will last either 5 or 10 minutes, dependent on how many students each teacher has in their class(es). If you do not have access to the internet, please contact the school office who will be happy to add appointments on your behalf.
