

Waddesdon CE School: 16 to 19 Tuition Fund Statement 2023-24

The 16 to 19 Tuition Fund was first provided by the government from the academic year 2020 to 2021 and is now extended for a further two years, until 2023 to 2024. It is designed to support students who meet specific criteria to mitigate against the disruptive impact of the COVID-19 pandemic on their education.

Although support from the tuition fund does not need to be for GCSE English or Maths, it is only to support students who:

- have not achieved a grade 6 in GCSE English and/or Maths
- live in the 27% most economically deprived areas of the country (based on the index of multiple deprivation) and would need catch-up support
- are economically disadvantaged who meet the 16 to 19 Bursary Fund eligibility criteria and would need catch-up support to reach their full potential will be eligible, even where their prior attainment is high
- are aged 19 to 24 who have an education, health, and care (EHC) plan are also eligible for support, subject to meeting the eligibility for the fund

The school has been given a limited amount of money from this fund to support students who meet the above criteria and whose learning has been disrupted by the COVID-19 pandemic.

The fund is not limited to students with their GCSE English Language and/or Maths but can be used for any aim within a student's 16-19 programme of study.

For the students identified as meeting the criteria above, support will be established on the basis of individual progress and need. Typically, support will be in the form of small group tuition (maximum group size 5 students and 7 in exceptional circumstances) over and above teaching already timetabled for subjects. Tuition and additional support may be delivered using a blend of online and in-school delivery.

1. Students in Year 13 and 12 who have not yet achieved a grade 4 in GCSE English and/or Maths.	In addition to timetabled resit lessons in school, students will receive small group virtual tuition via tlclive.com , including holidays.	Students achieve grade 4 in Nov or June resit GCSE exam series in Sixth Form.	
2. Targeted support for Year 13 who fit the GCSE profile and/or 16-19 Bursary and/or postcode criteria above, who are identified on reports as behind or by their teachers.	In addition to interventions put in place in school, students will receive small group tuition, delivered by a teacher after school.	Students reported as on target at next report. Students achieve target grade in final exams. Students achieve their post 18 aspiration.	

Small group tuition might be subject specific or focused on exam literacy, careers or pastoral support.
