## **OPTION 1: From the Main Reception during the school day**

Email or call to confirm a date and time for collecting from the school reception area during the school day before the end of term on Wednesday 20th December. (Reception is open 8am-4pm on Mondays and 8am-5pm on Tues-Thurs and 8am-3:30pm on Fridays)

## **OPTION 2: Via a sibling currently attending Waddesdon School**

Please give the name of the sibling, their form and if there is a preferred day of the week on which the work should be passed to them.

## **OPTION 3:** At the GCSE Presentation Evening to be held on Tuesday 9<sup>th</sup> January

Let us know that you are attending the event so that arrangements can be made for the work to be transferred to the library on the day

## Please note that storage space is always at a premium, especially as the current students build up their body of work. Therefore, any uncollected work will be disposed of at the end of January.
