Dear Parent/Carer

“A MAGICAL GAME SHOW”, BIRMINGHAM, THURSDAY 10 JULY 2025

I would like to invite your child to attend “Maths Inspiration”, a national programme of interactive Maths lecture shows for GCSE students, on Thursday 10 July 2025.

The event will run as part of the Maths Inspiration National Shows of 2025, in collaboration with Stand Up Maths. We hope that the show will enrich our students’ understanding of the mathematics, and demonstrate the links between the subject, winning strategies and the mysteries of magic.

Mr Nilan, Miss Bridges and I will accompany the students. We will travel to Birmingham by coach, leaving school at 8.00am and returning at approximately 2.30pm. Students should bring a packed lunch and a drink, and school uniform is to be worn.

Parents/carers are invited to make a payment of £34.00 towards the cost of the visit, to cover the educational session, staffing, transport and insurance. We do not want to exclude any student from the visit. However, without this financial support from parents, the visit may have to be cancelled. Therefore, if you are concerned about payment, please contact us in advance of the deadline as we may be able to direct you to agencies which might be able to support you.

If your son/daughter wishes to attend, we will require a **deposit of £15 by Tuesday 3 June**, and the balance of £19 will be due by Wednesday 4 July. Should you have difficulty meeting either of these deadlines, please do not hesitate to let us know by 3 June.

By making payment you agree that:

- your son/daughter may take part in this visit and you understand that he/she will be expected to comply with the School Behaviour Policy both whilst travelling and during the visit;
- you will inform the school of any changes to your son/daughter’s medical conditions, emergency contact numbers or any other information that you have already supplied to the school;
- your son/daughter may receive first aid and emergency treatment during the school day, on day trips, sporting fixtures and residential trips. This consent will be valid for the time your son/daughter is a student at Waddesdon CE School unless you inform us otherwise.
