

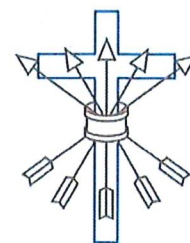

Dear Parents and Carers,

We are writing to seek your support in addressing an issue that has become increasingly concerning for local residents around school.

Over recent weeks, we have received a growing number of complaints regarding people parking outside homes, across driveways, and in ways that restrict access throughout the day. This not only causes inconvenience for residents and their visitors but also poses serious challenges for emergency services which require clear access at all times.

In addition, some people have been parking on side streets and, on occasion, illegally. Unfortunately, this has previously resulted in accidents and continues to cause significant distress within our community. We regularly receive concerns from residents in the following areas: Goss Avenue, Sharp's Close, Grove Way, Baker Street, Chestnut Close, and Golden Mede.



The Waddesdon Manor overflow car park is available for school drop off and pick up, which is only a five minute walk from the entrance gate. From the overflow car park, a footpath runs along the perimeter of the school, providing safe and easy access to the entrance to school.

While we appreciate that these arrangements may cause a small degree of inconvenience, adhering to them collectively will help prevent accidents, support our young people, and ensure we remain good neighbours to both local residents and Waddesdon Manor.

We are extremely grateful to Waddesdon Manor for facilitating this solution and ask that all drivers exercise care and responsibility when on Manor grounds. The parking system is already in place, and the overflow car park is available daily, whether the Manor is open or closed.

On days when the Manor is closed, you should use the call point on Silk Street to contact Waddesdon Security, who will be happy to lower the bollards for access. The red line on the map indicates the car route to the overflow car park, and the white line shows the footpath that you can use.

Thank you for your understanding and cooperation in this matter. Your support is greatly appreciated as we work together to ensure safety and maintain strong community relationships.
