Dear Parent/Carer,

Waddesdon Church of England School – 8th January 2026

Your child is now due their Year 9 secondary school vaccinations to protect them against Tetanus, Diphtheria, Polio (Td/IPV), Meningitis ACWY, and, if needed, Measles, Mumps and Rubella (MMR). These are important boosters to keep your child safe from serious illnesses.

What to do:

- Consent online: [TDIPV MenACWY Vaccination Consent Form \(buckschildimmunisations.co.uk\)](http://buckschildimmunisations.co.uk)
- Please fill in the online consent form by midday on **07/01/2026** using the school code **EE137355**
- If you can't get online, call the immunisation team and we'll help you over the phone.

Vaccinations will take place at your child's school on **08/01/2026**. Without consent, your child may not be vaccinated. If your child wishes to have the vaccine and you haven't given consent, we may check if they can consent themselves.

Vaccine details:

- Td/IPV (Tetanus, Diphtheria, Polio): A booster is needed in Year 9 for full protection. Given as a single injection.
- MenACWY: Protects against four types of meningitis and is given as a single injection at the same time as the Td/IPV booster.
- MMR: Two doses are needed for protection. If your child missed either of these doses, we can catch them up during the session.
