



RSHE Curriculum Parent/Carer Consultation May 2026

Dear parent/carers,

The government has introduced new relationships and sex education (RSE) and health education (HE) guidance that we are required to implement from 1 September 2026.

Because of this, we will be consulting with parents/carers, pupils and staff to make sure our new curriculum meets the government's requirements, as well as the needs of all our pupils.

We are currently working on our RSHE curriculum and policy to ensure they reflect:

- Our pupils' ages and developmental stages, as well as their physical and emotional maturity and cultural and religious backgrounds.
- Every pupil's learning needs, including the needs of any pupils with special educational needs and disabilities (SEND)
- Our school's vision and values
- What pupils need to know to be healthy and safe in school, in their personal relationships and in the wider world.

We launched a student questionnaire in April and have now organised for a number of student focus group meetings to discuss the results of the survey. We also completed a staff training session in April to explore the changes and what the new guidelines will mean for teaching staff and lesson content.
