The role is for **five days per week**, working **8.15 a.m. to 3.15 p.m.** The successful candidate will be calm, confident, flexible and able to build positive relationships with students. Previous experience of supervising secondary-aged students in a classroom environment is essential. Appropriate training and ongoing support will be provided. Applicants should hold **GCSEs (or equivalent) in English and Mathematics**. This role offers an excellent opportunity for suitably motivated candidates who are considering a career in teaching, providing valuable classroom experience and a potential route into teacher training.

Waddesdon School is an oversubscribed all ability 11-18 school, set in rural north Buckinghamshire. The school is 30 minutes away from Oxford and also within easy commuting distance from Milton Keynes. There are just over 1000 students on roll, including 300 in the Sixth Form. The school has an excellent reputation for CPD and recognises and values the contributions of all staff. There are realistic expectations regarding balancing family and leisure time and workload. Governors have recently changed the Admissions Policy to include children of staff members.
